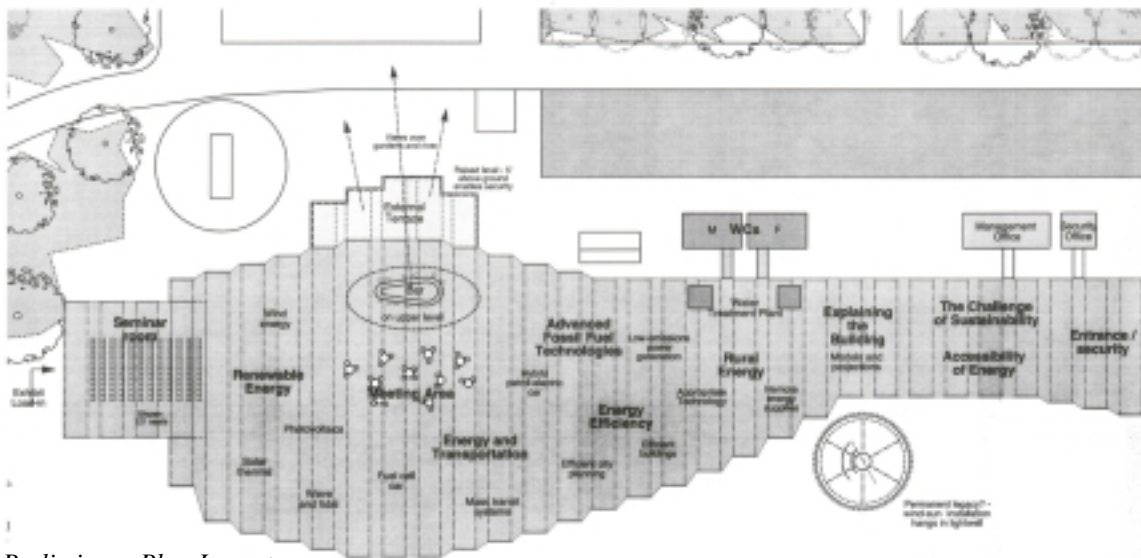


United Nations, North Lawn, NYC

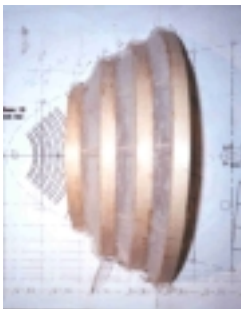
In collaboration with Robert Webb Associates, an architectural firm focusing on “Design for Sustainability,” we are developing a deployable exhibition hall to showcase positive sustainable solutions for energy and transportation. The exhibit is to run parallel with the ninth session of the UN Commission of Sustainable Development, Spring 2001.

The exhibit hall is a series of simple timber arches linked together with a fabric skin. The exhibit hall is scheduled to travel, so the structure's ability to store, assemble and disassemble is paramount to the design development.

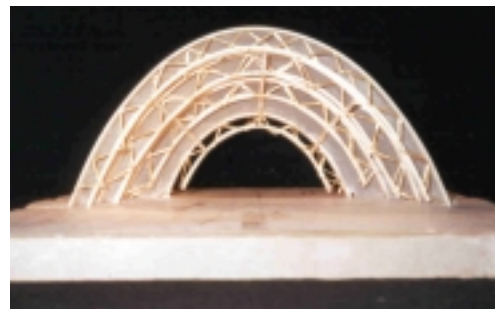
Preliminary Plan Layout
