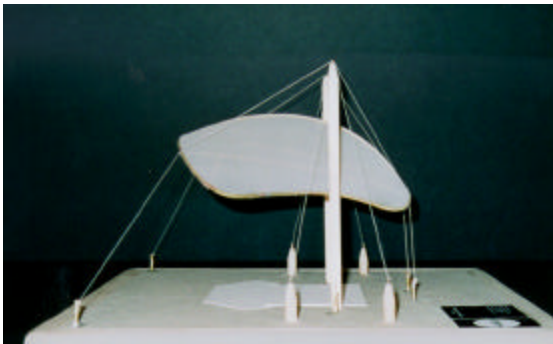


Project Proposal



Project: Prescott Performing Arts Center.
Location: Portsmouth, New Hampshire
Details: 2000 sf rigging/lighting truss.
Demountable for the winter and coastal summer storms

This 2000 sf stage cover is designed to be part of the scenic designers pallet. The performance facility presents varying shows from Peter Pan to Rock and Roll. The rigging grid/lighting grid responds to the production schedule.

The structure combines the cover and the lighting grid to form an aluminium shell structure. The angle and height of the grid is adjustable to meet each shows changing program, as well as dropping for summer storms or winter months. The fabric is non-structural and replaceable, thus allowing different fabric colors and properties to enhance the performance.

The two rigging masts and detailing mimics early 18th century ship construction , as the site is adjacent to an historic port on the coast in Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

This design proposal responds to the facilities diverse programing and historic park location with a great deal of flexibility to production designers.
